Title: FM Research – Meeting the needs of Industry?

What should drive the research agenda - academic interest or the needs of industry? This paper will explore research needs from the practitioner and academic perspectives, identifying consensus and divergence through the results of a 3 phase International Delphi project. The paper will present a 'State of the Art' analysis of current research activity and identify future research goals and agenda's from both the practitioner and academic perspectives. The paper will also present for further discussion the CIB W70 roadmap for Global Facilities Management research for the next 10 years.



Speaker: Keith Jones, Professor, University of Greenwich

Dr. Keith Jones is Professor of Facilities Management and Leader of the Sustainable Buildings Research Group at the University of Greenwich. His Group research a range of facilities management and built asset maintenance issues including: sustainability; built asset management; community resilience to climate change; occupant behaviour and carbon reduction; and innovation change management in the built environment. Prof Jones is a member of the UK REF 2014 Assessment Panel 16 and joint co-ordinator of CIB W70.
